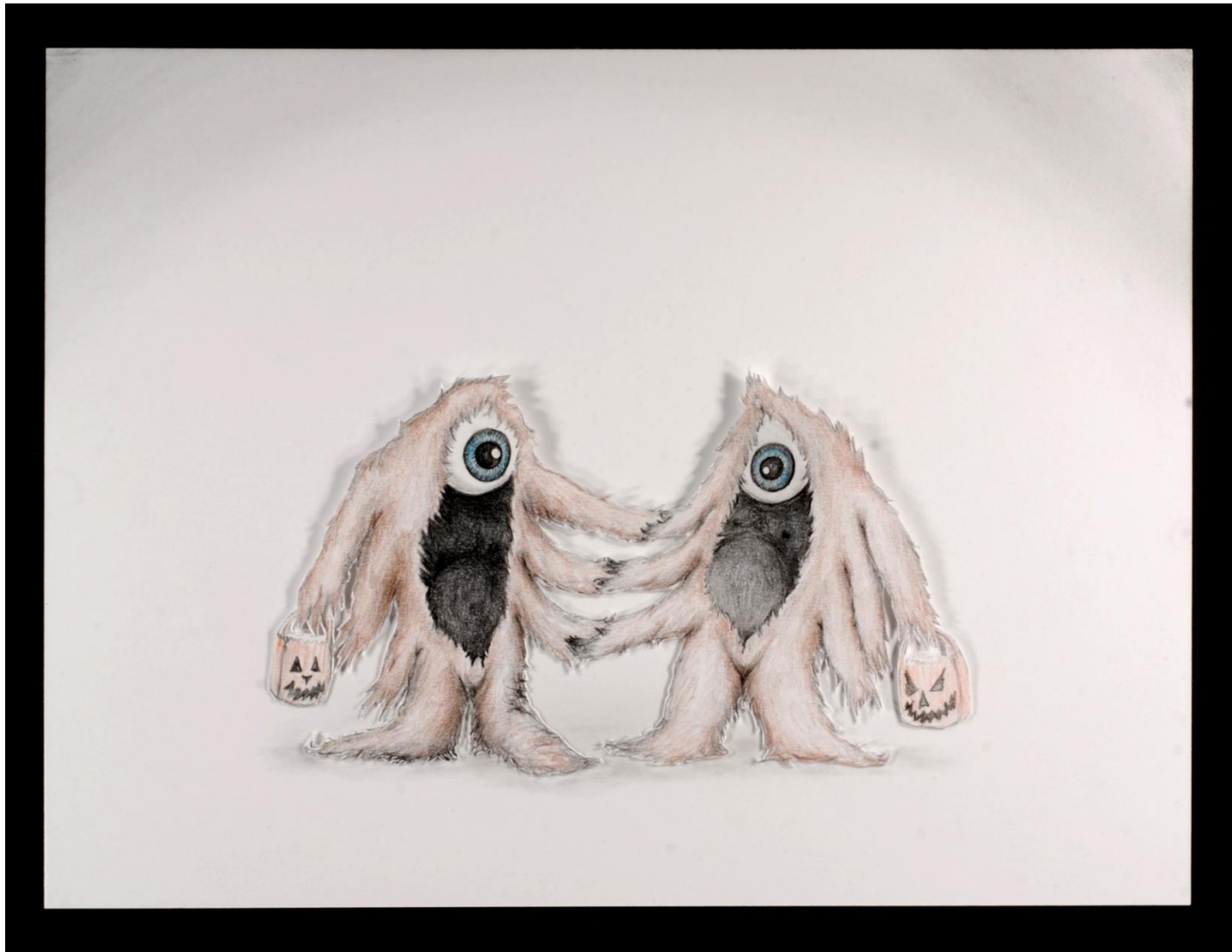


**1.**Don't be scared. Halloween is supposed to be fun so try not be scared no matter how realistic some costumes can be.

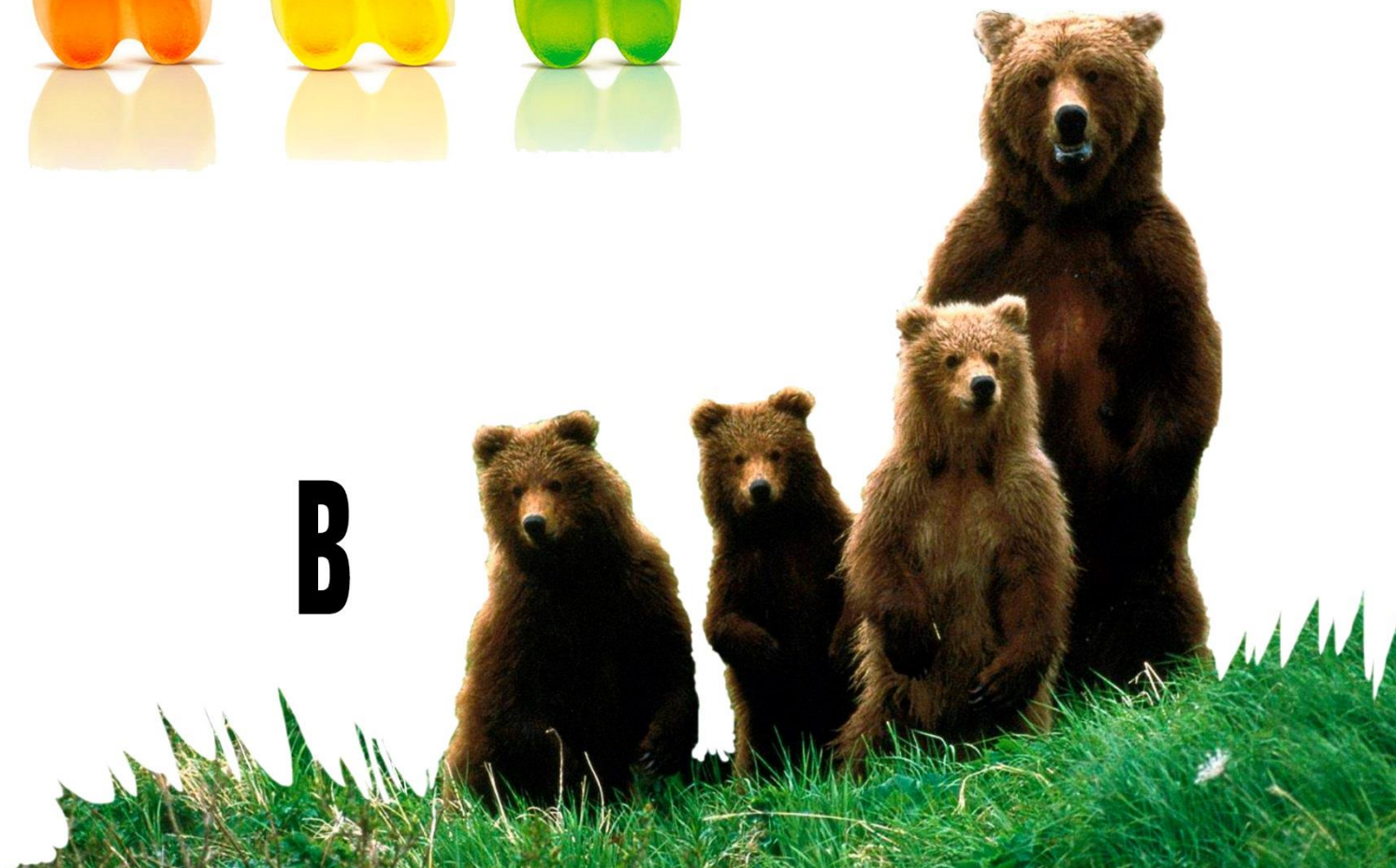
